

Uploading a Thumbnail



If an upload URL has already been generated for your thumbnail, you can use it instead for uploading the thumbnail.



Please note that the token in the upload URL is valid for four hours. This means that if the upload takes longer than four hours to complete, an error will occur. If this happens, perform the "Get thumbnail upload URL" request again to generate a new upload URL.

Request

curl -X POST -F "file=@/<FILENAME>" "https://file-1-b.video-cdn.net/FQMx5EcAGqS-789vU7s6QY/78463.UPLOAD_Bzg_-8GaCUeRDYhaLd3eCf.jpeg/still?mime-type=image%2Fjpeg&__token__=abc123"

URL	Description
UPLOAD_URL	An example upload URL is shown above. This is returned from the API's Get Thumbnail Upload URL endpoint.
Parameters	
token	The token is returned along with the upload URL and is valid for 4 hours (see warning above).
mime-type	The upload URL also contains the mime type of the image.
Form Data	
file=@/<FILENAME>	Indicate the filename (and path if necessary) of the local thumbnail image file to upload. Ensure that you add "@/" in front of the filename.
