


Content



In the Home panel under **Start Channel**, select a channel from the drop-down menu that will display the start video on the Home page in your CorporateTube.



"Start Channel" configuration is only available for CorporateTube accounts that are publicly available.

If your CorporateTube uses Single Sign-on (SSO), you can set a start video within the CorporateTube user interface with help of the context menu under each video.

In the **Sorted List** section, you can select the upload lists that should appear on your home page and in which order they should appear.

In the **Home Page Channel List** section, choose from the drop-down menu the channel(s) you want to appear on your CorporateTube home page.

Like in Channel Navigation, you can determine if the channel(s) in the list appear as root channels, where sub-channels are displayed by default.
