



Time-controlled Release


Optionally, you have the opportunity to release a video for a certain period of time automatically. For this purpose, you can define the period of time using exact hours.

1. Select the desired video in the video list by clicking on the appropriate entry.
2. Open the accordion menu **Security**.

4. Enter the desired start date and select the time from the drop down menu.
5. Define also the desired end date and time.
